

#### What is the Impact Factor (IF)?

[the average annual number of citations per article published]

For example, the 2016 impact factor for a journal is calculated as follows:

- A = the number of citation of articles published in 2016
- B = the number of articles published in 2014 and 2015
- 2016 impact factor = A/B
- e.g. 600 citations / 150 + 150 articles = 2




#### What is the CiteScore?


[the average annual number of citations per article published]

For example, the 2016 impact factor for a journal is calculated as follows:

- A = the number of citation of articles published in 2016
- B =the number of articles published in 2013, 2014, 2015
- 2016 impact factor = A/B
- e.g. 600 citations / 100 +150 + 150 articles =1.5

### Journal Quartile (Q)

The Journal quartile is the quotient of a journal's rank in category (X) and the total number of journals in the category (Y), so that (X / Y) = Percentile Rank Z.

What is the Predatory Journal? What is the Hijacked Journal?





Predatory journals - also called fraudulent, deceptive, or pseudojournals - are publications that claim to be legitimate scholarly journals, but misrepresent their publishing practices.

There are about 15,000 predatory journals



Can a Scopus journal be predatory?

Predatory journals exploit the author pays open access model, and conduct only cursory or no peer review, despite claims to the contrary. Some such journals will publish almost anything for money.

### **How to Identify the Predatory Journals?**




#### 1. Always check the website thoroughly


- Spelling and grammar on their website.
   Poor use of language shows a low professional standard.
  - The journals' fees should be clearly stated on the website and should only be requested from the author after the article has been accepted for publication.
- If a journal requests a submission fee before the article is accepted, this may be a predatory journal.



# 2. Check if the journal is a member of DOAJ, COPE

If they advertise membership to the Directory of Open Access Journal (DOAJ) and/or Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE), check it directly through website





#### 3. Check the journal's contact information

- It is important to ensure there is verifiable contact information that matches the advertised nationality of the journal.
  - Journal used unofficial Email (Gmail, Yahoo, etc.)


# 6. Read through past issues of the journal

• Beall's List is a list of predatory open-access publishers and journals that was maintained by University of Colorado librarian Jeffrey Beall










# Avoid the Journal that do the following:

- They frequently send you an invitation letter to contribute in the next issue.
- They offer you to become as a member of editorial board / guest editor in the journal.



# **Hijacked Journals**

- Hijacked journals are duplicate or fake websites of official ones using the title, ISSN and other information of the reputable journal.
- They are often created by a malicious third party for the purpose of fraudulently offering academicians the opportunity to rapidly publish their research online for a fee.



# **Hijacked Journals**

- 1st hijacked printed journal: In 2012, cyber criminals began hijacking print-only journals by registering a domain name and creating a fake website under the title of the legitimate journals.
- 1st hijacked Electronic journal: The first journal to be hijacked recorded was the Swiss journal Archives des Sciences. In 2012 and 2013, more than 20 academic journals were hijacked. In some cases, scammers find their victims in conference proceedings, extracting authors' emails from papers and sending them fake calls for papers



# **Hijacked Journals**

- Hijackers take over the journal's existing domain name after the journal publisher neglects to pay the domain name registration fees on time.
- John Bohannon identified 24 journals indexed by Clarivate whose web domains appear to have been recently hijacked. The authors loss is about \$ 217,000.

- Publishing your research in a hijacked journal will waste your effort and money without any benefit.
